Official Launching of Ministry of Education Website

The Minister for Education, Mrs. Macsusy Mondon will officially launch the Ministry of Education website in a ceremony at the SITE Auditorium on Friday 20th November 2015, at 09.00am.

The ceremony will be attended by Ministers, Principal Secretaries, numerous officials from the Ministry of Education, national and international education partners and stakeholders.

The Ministry of Education website has been developed in collaboration with the department of ICT in the office of the Vice-President, Microsoft Indian Ocean Islands and French Pacific (IOIFP), and Formation Recrutement et Conseil Informatique Ltée (FRCI).

Two consultants from FRCI, Mr. Akthar Dilmohamud and Mr. Hemant Bulleeray, are presently in Seychelles working with the technical and content development teams from the Ministry of Education and training the officers who will be responsible for managing the content on the website.

The previous Ministry of Education website had some limitations in terms of the content that could be provided online which meant that information on the website was limited. Additionally the previous website was built on infrastructure that did not allow for proper security and easy updates.

The new website which will be launched on Friday has been developed using modern technologies with the aim of providing parents, teachers, students and education officers a platform to communicate and access up to date information.

During the ceremony on Friday, the guests will also be given a demo of the live website once it has been launched, and view the many new features and content that are accessible.
